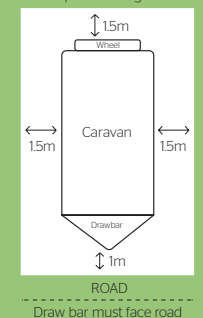

Guest information

Please take the time to read, understand and adhere to these guidelines to ensure that everyone enjoys their stay:

Welcome to RAC Cable Beach Holiday Park. The following provides basic information for your stay. For any other information not covered here, please see reception. All guests are requested to observe the instructions displayed around the property and to abide by any direction from Management.

Arrival/Departure

Check in is available from 2pm on the day of your scheduled arrival, unless prior arrangements have been made with Management. All rooms/ sites to be vacated by 10am on day of departure. Should you wish to check out before reception opens or extend your stay, please contact reception.

Amenities

Amenities blocks are located throughout the property. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times. Please consider others when using these facilities by leaving them in a neat and tidy condition.

BBQ areas

Guest BBQ areas are available throughout the property for your convenience and are marked on the park map. Please remember to leave the area clean after use. Please note that open fires are prohibited at the property.

Bikes and scooters

Bikes and scooters can be used throughout the property as long as protective gear and helmets are worn. Road rules must be observed and bikes are not to be ridden at the main entrance/exit area. Children must be supervised at all times and usage is to be limited to daylight hours only.

Camp kitchen

A camp kitchen is available for use by all guests. Guests are asked to consider others when using these facilities and ensure the area is left clean after use.

Dump point

A dump point is available for guests. Please consult map for location.

E-rideables

Recreational e-rideables (including e-scooters, e-skateboards and e-bikes) are not permitted to be operated within RAC Cable Beach Holiday Park. This does not apply to mobility scooters or motorised wheelchairs.

Electricity and Lithium-Ion Battery safety during your stay

Only use 15A leads on powerheads. Do not overload connection by excessive use of power boards or double adaptors. Do not leave lithium-

ion batteries such as e-rideables unattended, on charge overnight or for extended periods.

Emergency assembly point

To ensure the safety of all guests, we request that you familiarise yourself with our emergency assembly area as marked on the map. In case of emergency, please remain calm and follow instruction from staff.

Fish cleaning

Fish cleaning is only to be undertaken in the designated fish cleaning area. In the interest of other guests, please ensure that the area is left clean and free from offal. Please use the freezer provided for offal.

Generators

The use of generators is not permitted.

General store

An on-site General store and café is available for your bread, ice, milk, and newspapers. They also serve a range of meals daily and you can book and pay to play Mini Golf here.

Internet

Wi-Fi is available throughout the property providing complimentary access to guests. Please be aware that some black-spots occur at various locations around the property. **Wi-Fi password: cable1234**

Laundry

A public laundry is available onsite and is located in the main ablution block. Machines are coin operated and change is available from reception during opening hours. Please use the clotheslines provided.

Motorbikes and quadbikes

No unlicensed motorbikes or quad-bikes are to be ridden in the property or surrounding areas (please refer to local council for designated areas and rules).

Noise

Please be respectful of other guests within the park by restricting noise from television, music & social gatherings between the hours of 10pm & 7am.

Parking

One vehicle only is allowed per site. Visitor parking is available at front reception. No visitor vehicles are permitted in the park.

Pets

Dogs must remain on a lead and under control at all time. Pet bond will be forfeited for any damage or disturbance. Pets must not be left unattended.

Recreational areas

Please note that children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times in our recreational areas. No sharp objects or glass is permitted in these areas. Pool hours and rules are displayed at the gate before entry. While walking around the property, please ensure pathways are used, and if walking at night time a torch is highly recommended.

Rubbish

All areas are to be kept clean and tidy. Rubbish is to be tied in a plastic bag before disposing in the bins provided to restrict flies and ants.

Security

While Management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, we do recommend that visitors to the property take the precaution of securing items of value and ensuring vehicles and doors are locked.

Speed limits

All roads in the park are shared between pedestrian and vehicles. Speed limits are restricted to 8km/per hour (walking pace) at all times.

Smoking/Vaping

Please note that smoking of cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vaping is not permitted in any accommodation, amenities or common areas.

Tours

Our reception staff are only too happy to assist with any queries you may have about tours and activities available in the area.

Visitors

Please be aware that any visitors that you invite to the park must adhere to the property's condition of entry and will be the responsibility of the guest. Visitors may leave their car in the guest carpark and must be offsite by 10pm.

Water Usage

Washing of vehicles, caravans, boats and/or trailers is not permitted in the park.
