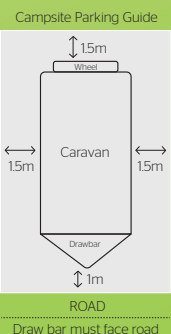

Guest information

Please take the time to read, understand and adhere to these guidelines to ensure that everyone enjoys their stay:

Welcome to RAC Esperance Holiday Park. The following provides basic information for your stay. For any other information not covered here, please see reception. All guests are requested to observe the instructions displayed around the property and to abide by any direction from Management.

Arrival/Departure

Check in is available from 2pm on the day of your scheduled arrival, unless prior arrangements have been made with management. All rooms/ sites to be vacated by 10am on day of departure. Should you wish to check out before reception opens or extend your stay, please contact reception.

Amenities

Amenities blocks are located throughout the property. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times. Please consider others when using these facilities by leaving them in a neat and tidy condition.

BBQ areas

Guest BBQ areas are available throughout the property for your convenience and are marked on the map. BBQ's will turn off automatically, please remember to leave the area clean after use.

Beach Access

To ensure you can safely access the beach. Please use the crossing located just outside of the front gates in front of reception.

Bikes and scooters

Bikes and scooters can be used throughout the property as long as protective gear and helmets are worn. Road rules must be observed and bikes are not to be ridden at the entrance/exit areas or in amenities and common areas. Children must be supervised at all times and usage is to be limited to daylight hours only.

Camp kitchen

There are 2 camp kitchens. One is located at the front of the park near the games room and pool area. The other is at the back of the park near the BBQ and picnic area.

Camp fires

Fire pits, open fires and charcoal BBQs are not permitted within the park. However, we offer gas BBQ facilities for you to use during your stay

CCTV

Please be aware that surveillance cameras are used within the property

Clotheslines

Clotheslines are available throughout the park. Please see map for locations. We request that temporary clotheslines are not erected.

Dog Wash

Pamper your pet after a day at the beach with our on site dog wash, located at the western entry of the rec room.

Dump point

A dump point is available for the use of guests. Please consult map for locations.

E-rideables

Recreational e-rideables (including e-scooters, e-skateboards and e-bikes) are not permitted to be operated within RAC Esperance Holiday Park. This does not apply to mobility scooters or motorised wheelchairs.

Emergency assembly point

To ensure the safety of all guests, we request that you familiarise yourself with our emergency assembly area as marked on the map. In case of emergency, please remain calm and follow instruction from staff.

Electricity and Lithium-Ion Battery safety during your stay

Only use 15A leads on powerheads. Do not overload connection by excessive use of power boards or double adaptors. Do not leave lithium-ion batteries such as e-rideables unattended, on charge overnight or for extended periods.

Electric Vehicle Charging

EV Charging station in the parking area above reception.

Fish cleaning

Please use the fish cleaning station located on the jetty as there is no fish cleaning station at the park. Please ensure that you clean up after yourselves to ensure you are being respectful to the next person.

Generators

The use of generators is not permitted.

General store

A small selection of souvenirs, ice-creams, cold drinks, ice, milk and bait are available for purchase at our onsite general store.

Laundry

Laundry blocks are provided around the park for guest use. Please see guest map for locations. Machines are gold coin operated and change is available from reception during operating hours. Washing powder is available for a small charge from reception.

Internet

Wi-Fi is available throughout the property providing complimentary access to guests Wi-Fi password : **greatocean9876**

Motorbikes and quad bikes

No unlicensed motorbikes or quad-bikes are to be ridden in the property or surrounding areas (please refer to local council for designated areas and rules).

Noise

Please be respectful of other guests within the park by restricting noise from television, music & social gatherings between the hours of 10pm & 7am.

Parking

One vehicle only is allowed per site. Visitor parking is available above reception. No visitor vehicles are permitted in the park.

Pets

Dogs must remain on a lead and under control at all times. In order to have pets on the property you must follow the parks pet rules.

Recreational areas

Please note that children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times in our recreational areas. No sharp objects or glass is permitted in these areas. While walking around the property, please ensure pathways are used, and if walking at night time a torch is highly recommended.

Rubbish

All areas are to be kept clean and tidy. Rubbish is to be tied in a plastic bag before disposing in the bins provided to restrict flies and ants.

Security

While Management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, we do recommend that visitors to the property take the precaution of securing items of value.

Smoking/Vaping

Please note that smoking of cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vaping is not permitted in any accommodation, amenities or common areas.

Speed limits

All roads in the park are shared between pedestrian & vehicles. Speed limits are restricted to 8km/per hour (walking pace) at all times.

Visitors

Please be aware that any visitors that you invite to the park must adhere to the properties condition of entry and will be the responsibility of the guest. Visitors may leave their car in the guest car park and must be off-site by 10pm.

Water

Please be aware that bore water is used for reticulation only. Drinking water is available through all taps fitted throughout the Park, however due to water restrictions, no washing of cars, boats and/or trailers is permitted at your site.
