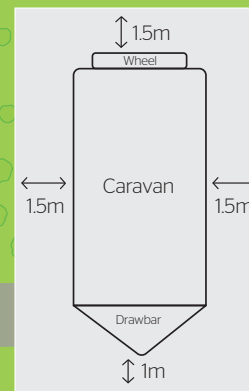

Guest information

Please take the time to read, understand and adhere to these guidelines to ensure that everyone enjoys their stay:

Welcome to RAC Exmouth Cape Holiday Park. The following provides basic information for your stay. For any other information not covered here, please see reception. All guests are requested to observe the instructions displayed around the property and to abide by any direction from Management.

Arrival/Departure

Check in is available from 2pm on the day of your scheduled arrival, unless prior arrangements have been made with Management. All rooms/sites to be vacated by 10am on day of departure. Should you wish to check out before reception opens or extend your stay, please contact reception.

Amenities

Amenities blocks are located throughout the property. Please see map for locations. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times. Please consider others when using these facilities by leaving them in a neat and tidy condition. Facilities are cleaned daily.

BBQ areas

Guest BBQ areas are available throughout the park for your convenience and are marked on the park map. Please remember to leave the area clean after use. Fire pits, open fires and charcoal BBQs are not permitted within the park.

Bikes and scooters

Bikes and scooters can be used throughout the property as long as protective gear and helmets are worn. Road rules must be observed and bikes are not to be ridden at the entrance/exit areas or in amenities and common areas. Children must be supervised at all times and usage is to be limited to daylight hours only.

Camp kitchen

Camp kitchens are available for use by all guests. Guests are asked to consider others when using this facility and to clean the area after use.

CCTV

Please be aware that surveillance cameras are used within the property.

Clotheslines

Clotheslines are available throughout the park. Please see map for locations. We request that temporary clotheslines are not erected.

E-rideables

Recreational e-rideables (including e-scooters, e-skateboards and e-bikes) are not permitted to be operated within RAC Exmouth Holiday Park. This does not apply to mobility scooters or motorised wheelchairs.

Electricity and Lithium-Ion Battery safety during your stay

Only use 15A leads on powerheads. Do not overload connection by excessive use of power boards or double adaptors. Do not leave lithium-

ion batteries such as e-rideables unattended, on charge overnight or for extended periods.

Emergency assembly point

To ensure the safety of all guests, we request that you familiarise yourself with our emergency assembly area as marked on the map. In case of emergency, please remain calm and follow instruction from staff.

Dump point

A dump point is available for the use of guests. Please consult map for locations.

Generators

The use of generators is not permitted.

Laundry

Laundry blocks are provided around the park for guest use. Please see guest map for locations. Machines are coin operated and change is available from reception during operating hours. Washing powder is available for a small charge from reception.

Internet

WIFI is available throughout the park providing complimentary access to guests. Please be aware that some black-spots occur at various locations around the park. **Wifi Password: racexmouth**

Motorbikes and quad bikes

No unlicensed motorbikes or quad-bikes are to be ridden in the park or surrounding areas (please refer to local council for designated areas and rules).

Noise

Please be respectful of other guests within the park by restricting noise from television, music & social gatherings between the hours of 10pm & 8am.

Parking

Only one car is permitted per site/cabin booking. If you have boats or trailers, please be aware these may need to be parked outside the park on Truscott Cres depending on the type of site/room you have booked. Please see reception for further information.

Pets

Dogs must remain on a lead and under control at all times. They must not be left unattended. Guests with pets who cause continued disturbances may be asked to leave the park.

Recreational areas

Please note that children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times in our recreational areas. No sharp objects, glass or alcohol are permitted in these areas. Pool rules are displayed at the gate before entry.

Rubbish

All areas are to be kept clean and tidy. Rubbish is to be tied in a plastic bag before disposing in the bins provided to restrict flies and ants. Fish cleaning is not permitted onsite. Please use shire facilities.

Security

While Park Managers do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, we do recommend that visitors to the park take the precaution of securing items of value.

Smoking/Vaping

Please note that smoking of cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vaping is not permitted in any accommodation, amenities or common areas.

Speed limits

All roads in the park are shared between pedestrian & vehicles. Speed limits are restricted to 8km/per hour (walking pace) at all times.

Visitors

Please be aware that any visitors that you invite to the park must adhere to the properties condition of entry and will be the responsibility of the guest. Visitors vehicles are not permitted inside the park and all visitors must be offsite by 10pm.

Water

Please be aware that bore water is used for reticulation only. Drinking water is available through all taps fitted throughout the Park, however due to water restrictions, no washing of cars, boats and/or trailers is permitted at your site. A wash bay is available for a small fee via reception. Bulk water tank filling is available next to the Big Prawn in town.

Wildlife

Please do not feed any of the wildlife as human food can be detrimental to their health and behaviour.
