

Guest information

Please take the time to read, understand and adhere to these guidelines to ensure that everyone enjoys their stay:

Welcome to RAC Monkey Mia Dolphin Resort. The following provides basic information for your stay. For any other information not covered here, please see reception. All quests are requested to observe the instructions displayed around the property and to abide by any direction from management.

Arrival/departure

Check in is available from 2pm on the day of your scheduled arrival. unless prior arrangements have been made with management. All rooms/ sites to be vacated by 10am on day of departure. Should you wish to check out before reception opens, you may leave your room key in the drop boxes outside of reception.

Amenities

Amenities blocks are located throughout the property. Please see map for locations. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times. Please consider others when using these facilities by leaving them in a neat and tidy condition. Facilities are cleaned daily cleaning times displayed at the entrance to each block.

BBO areas

Guest BBQ areas are available throughout the property for your convenience and are marked on the site map. Please remember to leave the area clean after use. Please note that open fires are prohibited at the property.

Beach access

Access to the beach is via designated pathways and access points at all times. Please refer to the site map for the location of these access points.

Bikes and scooters

Bikes and scooters can be used throughout the property as long as protective gear and helmets are worn. Road rules must be observed and bikes are not to be ridden at the entrance/exit areas or in amenities a nd common areas. Children must be supervised at all times and usage is to be limited to daylight hours only. Pedal karts are available for hire from Reception.

Camp kitchen

Camp kitchens are available for use by all quests. Guests are asked to consider others when using these facilities and to clean the area after use. Cutlery packs are available for hire at reception.

CCTV

Please be aware that surveillance cameras are used within the property.

Clotheslines

Clotheslines are available throughout the property. Please see map for locations. We request that temporary clotheslines are not erected.

Emergency assembly point

To ensure the safety of all guests, we request that you familiarise yourself with our emergency assembly area as marked on the map. In case of emergency, please remain calm and follow instruction from staff.

Dump point

A dump point is available for the use of quests. Please consult map for location.

Electricity and Lithium-Ion Battery safety during your stay

Only use 15A leads on powerheads. Do not overload connection by excessive use of power boards or double adaptors. Do not leave lithiumion batteries such as e-rideables unattended, on charge overnight or for extended periods.

Fish cleaning

Fish cleaning is only to be undertaken in the designated fish cleaning area. In the interest of other quests, please ensure that the area is left clean and free from offal. Please dispose of offal in freezer provided.

Generators

The use of generators is not permitted.

Laundry

Laundry blocks are provided around the property for quest use. Please see guest map for locations. Machines are coin operated, and change is available from reception during operating hours. Washing powder is available for a small charge from the General store.

Internet

Wifi is available throughout the property providing complimentary access to guests. Please be aware that some black-spots occur at various locations around the property. Additional data is able to be purchased on

Motorbikes and quad-bikes

No unlicensed motorbikes or quad-bikes are to be ridden in the property or surrounding areas (please refer to local council for designated areas and rules).

Noise

Please be respectful of other quests within the park by restricting noise from television, music & social gatherings between the hours of 10pm & 8am.

Parking

One car is permitted per reservation. Should additional parking be required, please notify reception prior to your arrival to check availability.

Pets

Dogs must remain on a lead and under control at all times. They must not be left unattended. As outlined in our pet policy, a bond may be deducted for any damage or disturbances. Pets not permitted indoors unless they are a registered service animal.

Recreational areas

Please note that children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times in our recreational areas. No sharp objects, glass or alcohol are permitted in these areas. Pool rules are displayed at the gate before entry.

All areas are always to be kept clean and tidy. Rubbish (including cans. bottles, plastic, paper) is to be tied in a plastic bag before disposing in the bins provided. No rubbish is to be dumped or left on foreshore areas.

Security

While management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment. we do recommend that visitors to the property take the precaution of securing items of value.

Smoking/Vaping

Please note that smoking of cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vaping is not permitted in any accommodation, amenities or common areas.

Speed limits

All roads in the park are shared between pedestrian & vehicles. Speed limits are restricted to 8km/per hour (walking pace) at all times.

Stormwater management

Uncontrolled stormwater drainage from the Resort has the potential to negatively impact marine species as it can transport rubbish, sediment and nutrients into the marine environment. Stormwater management drains have been installed on the property to contain stormwater and prevent it flowing to the foreshore area and into the marine environment.

Our reception staff are only too happy to assist with any queries you may have about tours and activities available in the area.

TV reception for campers

Ty aerial cables are available for purchase at reception to plug in to the campsite powerheads.

Please be aware that any visitors that you invite to the park must adhere to the properties condition of entry and will be the responsibility of the guest. Visitors may leave their car in the guest car park and must be offsite by 10pm.

Please be aware that bore water is used for reticulation only. Drinking water is available through all taps fitted throughout the park, however due to water restrictions, no washing of cars, boats and/or trailers is permitted in the park. Please contact reception if you would like to fill any tanks.

Wildlife

Please do not feed the wildlife as food can be detrimental to their health. and behaviour
