REX Airlines on selected days of the week.

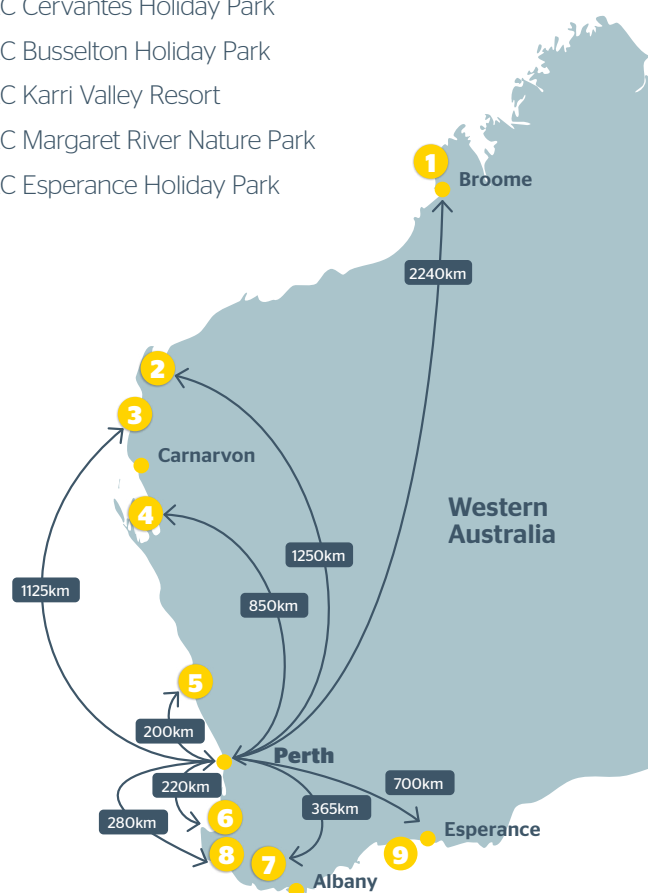
